Grain Donations Procedures
St. Gabriel Communications Siouxland Catholic Radio



 St. Gabriel Communications/Siouxland Catholic Radio (hereafter referred to as St. Gabriel Communications) accepts donations of grain from farmers with local elevators for charitable

use.

- A representative from St. Gabriel Communications will open an account with the elevator, if not previously established, in anticipation of the grain donation. Please contact Lisa Niebuhr or Ann Reed at the station (phone: 712-224-5342; email: lisaniebuhr@fhcradio.com or annreed@fhcradio.com) or Kathy Pynn (via email at kapynn@aol.com) in advance so an account can be established prior to delivery.
- The farmer must deliver grain to the elevator or currently hold grain in their name to provide proof of production.
- The farmer transfers the ownership title of the commodity to **St. Gabriel Communications by December 26 of each year.**
- The farmer contacts **St. Gabriel Communications** regarding the grain donation.
- St. Gabriel Communications must make the final decision to sell the grain.
- The donor does not recognize the income from the sale of the grain.
- St. Gabriel Communications will send an acknowledgement to the farmer for the grain donation.
 - The acknowledgement will indicate the number of bushels of donation grain and the date the grain was received.
 - Since grain is a property or "non-cash" contribution, the value of the donation will not be included.
 - A copy of the check from the elevator, the grain transfer form, and other applicable forms provided by the grain elevator will also be included.

Please note:

- Contracted grain sales will not be accepted as a grain donation.
- Gifts of grain are accepted as a donation to the station.
- All gifts of grain must have a minimum value of \$1,000.00.
