Second Annual Juried Youth Art Festival, April 11-14, 2023

Theme: *St. Gabriel and the Angels as Messengers*

Who: 1st – 12th grade students (*Enrolled in a Catholic school or a Catholic student enrolled in a public or home school in the Tri-State area.*)

What: Students will create a visual arts submission (using the media of their choice except for photography) in keeping with this year's theme.

Quantity: There are no limits as to the number of entries submitted by each school and/or parish.

Adjudicators: Esteemed Siouxland artists will evaluate the students' artwork based on creativity, originality, theme, and excellence.

Submissions Deadline: Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at 4 p.m.

Winners:

- **Placings:**

- **First, Second, and Third Place winners** will be announced in each grade level.
 - Each of the winners will receive a certificate.
 - The 1st Place Winner's artwork in each grade will be featured in the 2024 2nd Annual Juried Youth Art Festival Calendar.
- **Curators' Choice:**
 - The winner will receive a certificate.
 - Receive a 1-hour private art session by one of the adjudicators.
- **Viewers' Choice:**
 - Viewers can vote during the Art Festival at the station. One vote per viewer.
 - The winner will be announced on-air on Friday, April 21.

- A **reception** for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place winners in each grade (*except for the Viewers' Choice*), their parents/guardians, siblings, teachers, school administrators, and/or judges will be held on **Thursday, April 13**, during the pledge drive **from 4-5 p.m.**
- The 1st Place winners, their parent/s and/or guardian/s, and judges will be **guests during Thursday's Pledge Drive**. Guests will be notified in advance as to their assigned time slot. The pledge drive can be heard on-air (88.1 FM) and watched via the station's **YouTube Channel**.

- Friday, April 21** Viewers' Choice Winner will be announced on air. **NEW in 2023:** The 1st Place winners, their parent/s or guardian/s, and/or teacher must provide a head and shoulder photo (either a jpeg or png format).
- April 24-May 17** Exhibited artwork is available for pick up at Siouxland Catholic Radio (*NEW in 2023: Schools participating in the Bishop's Mass are invited to stop by the station to pick up their artwork and tour the historic St. Boniface Church, the station's home.*)
- Saturday, May 6** **NEW in 2023:** The 1st Place winners in each grade, Viewers' Choice, and Curator's Choice artwork may be displayed at Siouxland Catholic Radio for the First Ever Siouxland Catholic Ministries Fair.

SIouxLAND CATHOLIC RADIO'S SECOND ANNUAL JURIED YOUTH ART FESTIVAL GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY

- Catholic School Art teachers, Religious Education/Faith Formation, and teachers/parents of homeschoolers may submit for the jurying process.
- Only one submission per student.
- International students enrolled in a Catholic school during the 2022-2023 school year can participate.

CRITERIA

- Artwork must be started after the beginning of the current school year and completed prior to the March 22 deadline.
- Originality, creativity, theme, and an expressive response to the media.
- Workmanship should be of a very high quality.
- 2-D work does not need to be matted for the jurying process. Siouxland Catholic Radio will not provide matting and framing.
- 3 –D work should be display-ready for the jurying process.
- Charcoal and pastels work must be FIXED with a spray fixative before the jurying process.
- Please do not submit entries on “lined” paper.
- Art pieces must have been created solely by the student.
- **Photography entries and entries created on “lined” paper** will not be accepted.
- Artwork will be displayed on tables by Siouxland Catholic Radio.

SPECIFICATIONS

- The size restrictions for 2-D work is **11” x 14”** as the largest measurement and no size limitation for the smallest dimension. No restriction for 3-D work.
- Each work must be properly identified with a title.
- All artwork must have the label provided (*or photocopy of such, see following pages*) affixed to the back of the artwork.
- A completed inventory form must be submitted by each teacher, faith formation director, or home schoolteacher/parent.
- A consent to release information signed by the parent/guardian.

GENERAL PROGRAM RULES

All entries not in compliance with the following rules and restrictions will be disqualified and will not be judged.

ENTRIES:

1. Artwork must be started after the beginning of the current school year and completed prior to March 22.
2. Only the student may work on his or her artwork under the supervision and critique of a teacher from the student's school, faith formation director, or parent (if home-schooled).
3. **Setting:**
 - For Catholic school students, although the majority of the work must take place in the school setting, a student may work on the artwork outside the classroom environment but **may not receive instruction, guidance, or critique from anyone other than the supervising teacher** (*for example, a private instructor, teacher, or professional advisor*).
 - For students in public or home schools, although the majority of the work will take place in the student's home, the students **may not receive instruction, guidance, or critique from anyone other than their public or home schoolteacher/parent** (*for example, a private instructor, teacher, or professional advisor*).
4. Artwork created under the supervision of any person, teacher, or instructor outside the aforementioned settings is not eligible for Siouxland Catholic Radio's Art Festival.
5. All artwork must be the student's original composition and content and individual expression.
 - a. Published images **MAY NOT** be reproduced in whole or part and used as the student's primary reference source. Published images include, but are not limited to, drawings, sketches, or photographs published electronically (*eBooks, mobile apps, websites, etc.*) or in print (*magazines, books, brochures, etc.*). Releases to use published or copyrighted images will not be accepted.
 - b. **Photography entries and entries created on "lined" paper** will not be accepted.
 - c. Students **MAY** use published images (electronic or print) as a *secondary* reference source. Secondary reference sources should never be the main idea of the artwork and should not be directly reproduced in whole or part. They may only be used as a frame of reference for backgrounds and/or in support of the main image.
 - d. Trademarked logos, slogans, and licensed characters are **not permitted** in part or in whole. This also applies to the title of the artwork.
 - e. Maximum restriction for 2-D work 11" X 14." No restrictions for 3-D work.

ADJUDICATION:

The following criteria will be considered by our esteemed artists. Originality, creativity, composition, and theme will be heavily weighted along with the student's ability to apply technical skills and artistic excellence.

a. Originality:

- Is the concept or idea original?
- Is it the student's own work and/or does the work show composition with multiple sources?
- Does it appeal to a wide-ranging audience?

b. Creativity:

- Does the piece of art show the student's imagination?
- Is the subject matter unique?
- Is the interpretation innovative?

- c. **Theme:** Does the submission clearly communicate the theme?
- d. **Skill:** Skill is assessed based on the age of the artist.
- e. **Excellence in drawing (2D only):**
 - What extent of accuracy has the student achieved?
 - How difficult is the chosen media?
 - How well does the student draw, use color, hues, shading, and texture?
- f. **All artwork must:**
 - **Have a title.** Identifying information may not be included in the title.
 - **Be accompanied by a brief explanation regarding the student's inspiration** (*see label*).
- g. **Identifying Information:**
 - Due to blind judging, artwork may **not** have identifying information located anywhere on the artwork including the front, back, bottom, and sides.
 - Identifying information may not be included on the Source Information Form or any of the sources. Identifying information includes the student's name, signature, school's and/or parish's name, teacher's name, etc.
